EXCLUSIVE INTERVIEW WITH TO, TEAM QUOTES, MORTAL FAGS KILLED IN DRIVE-BY SHOOTING, A MURDER MYSTERY IN THE CITY

Following a raucous week of OC, gossip, and drama, this bird-brained reporter ventured out from Youkai Mountain to the Outside World. Destination: One-Han City. In search of the famous meido charged with the task of organizing the region's yearly underground Mahjong Tournament: /mjg/ league 6.

the famous meido agreed to meet us here in the I.R.C. Ward of One-Han City – whose unabbreviated name has long been lost to time. It's here tucked away among the destitute churches and brothels that we find the Yakuman Bar and Grill. In the depths of it's furthest corner we met our subject – alone save for a half-finished drink and head of merlot hair.

Continuing our discussion we got back to talking about league preparations. Though the majority of the league's work happens in the month leading up to the draft, the post-draft interim isn't without it's own difficulty: 'I don't know how much time the collaborators put in creating streaming tools, scheduling, and coding. As for myself I can say for sure that this last week most of my free time has been totally dedicated to league.' While the denizens of One-Han City's /mjg/ district spend their days toiling in the OC mines the various organisers work hard making the whole event possible.

Laying time management aside we naturally started talking about the teams. With a turnout of 171 Jyanshis there were eighteen teams vying for a spot on the podium. We asked TO which teams he had on his radar: "I think teams 12 and 16 are the ones to look out for.". This came as no surprise, Teams 12 and 16 boasted two of the statistically strongest Jyanshis in the league, and topped out the Official Team Power Rankings (>> 523456165).

Aside from the two powerhouses the TO had one more team he wanted to mention: "I also believe that people are underestimating Team 9 and I'm expecting them to surprise many anons." I'll be Frank, this was the last team this bird-brained reporter expected him to list; Team 9 had been widely mocked in the district for their weak roster and forced memes plastered around the district, but perhaps TO saw a glimmer of Soul in that /bag/-shaped carapace.

Lastly the new Captains in the district got their own recognition: "I'm always interested in debuting captains, so let's see what ideas their teams come up with."

Teens Slayed; Killers at large

ate at night two days ago two Jyanshis aged 17 and 16 were found dead on Lake Herman Road on the outskirts of One-Han City. The high-school couple drove out to the city's limits last night at 8:30pm believed to be on their first date (the first one she had been permitted in her 16 years). Neither of them knew that it would be their last.

The One-Han City sheriffs investigators concede that they are no nearer to the solution of the crime than they were when they arrived on the scene of the grisly slayings that cold Friday night. Various police departments from other municipalities have been brought in to help with the case but despite the serious manpower the mystery of the Teen Slayer looms large. The couple (D and B for anonymity) had met at a youth function and

soon D was visiting B at her school. That night the couple were planning to attend a party with other students but cancelled last minute, embarking on their final detour.

Their car was found with the passenger door open; a bullet had penetrated the roof of the vehicle, and another through the rear window. Ten shell casings were found on the crime scene and D's body was found on the ground near the rear wheel on the passenger side. He was driving that night.

There were indications from where B's body was found that she had tried to flea but the Slayer fired five rounds while her back was still turned. Investigators note that it is unknown at this time whether the killer

was acting alone or in concert, and judging by bootprints and tire tracks discovered around the scene as many as nine Jyanshis may have been present. Whatever perverse motives incited the attack are at present beyond the comprehension of investigators and reporters alike.

This story follows after the double homicide six months prior involving two women who met their fate in similar circumstances to the teen couple. With this latest tragedy there has been local outcry in One-Han City that there may be mad gunmen on the loose .

Local law enforcement are considering these cases related and we will continue to provide updates as the case develops.
