Team 3: Legend of the Celestial Teapot (>>524607108)



CAT-ON-CAT VIOLENCE SPIKES

The streets of the /mjg/ district erupted in violence earlier this week as catgirls clashed with feline anthropomorphs.

On what would usually be a dull weekday afternoon in One-Han City suddenly exploded into action as nyaggers took to the streets in a Pogrom against the "furry menace".


Team 18: Zodiac Jyanshi (>>524607375)

TEAM 9'S TOUHOU THEMED INTRO

TEAM 9 INTERVIEWED; HERE'S WHAT THEY HAD TO SAY

TEAM 9 STOOD OUT BY BEING THE FIRST TOUHOU THEMED TEAM. CAN THEY LIVE UP TO THE CIRNO MONIKER AND BECOME THE STRONGEST?

We ventured into an anonymous Jyansou in One-Han City's bustling /mjg/ district to interview one of the most impactful teams this season. Comprised mostly of /bag/ migrants and an ex-TO we present our full interview with Team 9.

n an inconspicuous backstreet in One-Han City we met Team 9; this already came as some surprise as the team styled itself as being composed of fellow Gensokyo residents, but it quickly became apparent that this wasn't the case; the team Captain explained: 'we are avid Cosplayers who are really into Gensokyo fandom and culture, it's an honor to meet the real deal Ms Shameimaru'

Over the decades Gensokyo had become an object of fascination for many of the Jyanshi in the district; the influence of its charismatic residents and distinct culture has near-global reach. We got to talking about the residents and the team broke down who each of them were cosplaying as for the team – 'We have Kaguya, Nitori, Suika, Sanae, Remilia, Patchouli, Youmu, Yukari, and of course, Cirno'. Rather charmingly they also added that 'of course, you are listed as an honorary member'.

Pleasantries aside we started talking brass tacks; the members of Team 9 were no rookies, but they weren't battle-hardened Jyanshis like some of the other competitors in the League. They ranked middle of the pack in the power rankings, with a majority of the team attaining an Expert ranking in the One-Han City competitive circuit. On paper, the team looks quite weak.

When asked about their strategy going into the league they had a firm response: "I have unironically never had a single doubt in my mind that we can win – and have said as much to the team". "we might be 'weaker' on paper, but results are a different matter". They might be right, the ex-TO on their team is no tourist to the district, with years of mahjong experience under his belt that wasn't reflected in his rank. Addressing this they added "We have also been on an intense training arc, and perhaps the Cirno maths classes might be revealed to the public soon", insinuating that there might be some OC on the horizon in the near future.

With 160 Hanchans played by each team in the league, a number higher than most Pro Mahjong circuits hit, the /mjg/ district's league six should reflect this training outside of the usual variance expected in

Riichi Mahjong, we'll have to wait to see if the team's efforts bear fruits over the coming weeks. But in a message of clear conviction, and perhaps a nod to the mountain from which this Youkai reporter hails, they seemed determined to win: 'Faith gives power after all'.

We finished up our tea and before their bouncer saw me to the door I asked if they had any parting words for the readers in the district: "/bag/ still > /mjg".

On that bombshell, I've been your faithful reporter Aya Shameimaru, and thank you for reading.
