WEEK FOUR: THE SCORES ON THE BOARD

SHAKEUP AT THE TOP 8, SHINRYAKU IKAMUSUTEN KEEP LEAD, THE END OF QUALIS IS JUST ONE WEEK AWAY

With just one short week between us and knowing the final qualifiers things are heating up. The bottom 4 spots of the Top 8 are all up for grabs, but after scores get halved what will the situation look like for our semi-finalists?

hile the perennial duo in Bouryaku no Zvezdaten and Romance of the Cat Kingdoms have maintained their top 2 placement the same cannot be said of the rest of the top 8. Jet Set Riichi fell from grace this week with a staggering -270 point delta compared to last week. Not wanting to let themselves get beat in the wake of their Tea Party, Rosen Maiden: Füritend took a complete nosedive losing 310 points over the same period.

As we go into the last week of the qualifiers massive swings like this represent a real and permanent threat to the qualifying status of the remaining teams in contention.

Return to Normalcy

The last three weeks of the qualifying season have not disappointed with at least one Yakuman scored each week without fail, but this week deviated from that trend: perhaps a calm before the final week's storm?

On the same token the highs of individual Hanchans and Sessions remained fairly normal this week, with Grinchlantis securing the top Hanchan in Game 1 of EU19 walking away with a tidy +86.8 points. The top Session this week goes to Yakupara Cat Cafe with +133.8 in a single US18 Session.

The Cat Cafe's top player also overtook the previous title holder as the Most Valuable Player in the league. The team has been steadily building their points back up over the last two weeks and stand poised to make a run at the top 8.

Now for the losers of this week, and this week did not disappoint. The LVP has remained in the hands of a player from Jet Set Riichi, however the worst hanchan record was completely smashed this week in Game 1 of EU19 by Ransei no Tabi with an eye watering -103.8 points lost. The player lost 68,800 points that game, a true monument to Jyanshi's hubris in this fickle game.

Legend of the Celestial Teapot kicked off Week 4 with the worst Session of the week scoring -123.1 points in US18. Hurtling towards -1000 points this team just cannot catch a break. There's no prize for last!

Point Halving

At the end of this week the teams in the top 8 will go on to the semi-finals and their scores will be halved, bringing the field closer together to decide who goes through to the finals.

But what might that look like with the scores and positions as they currently are? To begin with, our first place and last place semi-finalists would have 225.3 and 83.7 points respectively – that's a delta of just 140 points, well within the reach of a single double first session, our largest so far being +1574 in a single session by Rozen Maiden.

This effectively melts away the massive leads the top teams have secured for themselves, and with the scores being halved again going into the finals that difference is going to be even more miniscule.

In short, once we reach the semis it's anyone's game and with just 40 Hanchans to play for each team each misstep or lucky play could make or break their shot at the finals.

One-Han City's Hottest Jyanshis

ne anonymous bulletin board poster conducted a poll of /mjg/denizens last Saturday asking the question on everyones minds: Which Jyanshi would you fuck? The results may surprise you.


The definitive losers of this list contained some iconic Jyanshi: Cynthia, Kiara, Anju, Kaavi, Yuzu, and Ayako all came in at just 6 votes.

Moving up the list we saw: Shiroko, Doragon, and Haruna at 7; Yagi Yui, and Hag at 8; and Hibiki, Xenia, Hana, and Chiori at 9 votes respectively.

Finally we get to what you've all been waiting for: the Top 5 (10) hottest Jyanshi.

At a tied 5th place we had Eliisa and Nadeshik. In another tie for 4th was Yuan Xiao (Panda) and Ransei. 3rd was a 3 way tie between the eternal beauty Fu Ji, the bunny on the moon Kaguya Hime, and [porcelain breaking sounds] Momo. 2nd was a tie between the luckiest Jyanshi, Nana Shiraishi and the perennial Ichihime. And at #1 with her new skin, was Kri Steve. For me, it's Drunk.

On Friday this week we saw teams converge around -100 after EU17 after Rozen Maiden and Bakyou Heat fell from 7th and 9th respectively to 9th and 10th. R.I.I.C.H.I took their place shortly after racing into the Top 8 over the last few days.

Following the release of their online sports betting cryptocurrency trading platform the Pinzu Pumpers experienced a massive rally in points landing them in 5th going into Week 5.

While there may be a 250 point gap between the Top 8 and the Sub Zero pack just a few good games stand between them and a place in the semis. But with so few games left to play every hanchan counts, and the situation looks incredibly bleak for the teams in the \cdot 300 point band.

EXCLUSIVE INTERVIEW WITH ZWEI

"CAPTAIN'S IN HIS HELL. ALL'S RIGHT WITH THE TEAM." WE SPOKE WITH ZWEIS GYARU-IN-CHIEF ABOUT THE TEAMS FUTURE

An organisation formed to prevent a total catastrophe from befalling One-Han City's /mjg/ district, and the world at large — ZWEI was birthed after the discovery of the prophecy of the Dead Wall Scrolls and stands vigil over Humanity. We interviewed them to find out more about this enigmatic team.

readers up on the events up until this point. In the week leading up to the start of the regular league season ZWEI's Captain and another high ranking teammate were discovered to have been cheating (more in Issue #1). Their expulsion is the backdrop to the ZWEIs immediate losses and following rise to the top.

Captainless, we asked a representative for the team how they adapted to what would be a team-sinking event for most, and how the last few weeks have been for the team:

"The last few weeks, you'd think something changed, when in reality it didn't. When our captain and saint left, we rallied together into a team capable of winning the entire league outright."

The team had a rough start, placing 2nd last at the end of the first week of the season, but have been slowly climbing the ranks to a peak of 2nd place:

"We were cripplingly unlucky in our starting games. A lot of late gyakutens or just getting luckshitted out of the game. Since we rode that part out we started getting the wins

we [needed]. I don't know if our Captain realized how great a team he assembled, but I couldn't have asked to be paired up with better teammates."



has been on an incredible trajectory these last 4 weeks, and stand a decent shot at taking the qualifiers. We asked how the team managed to pull this miracle off strategy wise, and what the team morale has been like these past few weeks:

"A lot of the strategy involved has been in trusting one another. When we're on the sidelines we're cheering, and when we're in the game we feel the momentum of every step carried by the teammate before. So it's nothing concrete of a strategy, but being so tightknit as a team has contributed greatly to ensuring we play our best and come back from every setback even stronger."

"As for our team morale, I think the early hic-ups of 4ths [got us down] a bit, but after getting our first 1st place, we got a surge in morale, and when we finally broke positive the fog had lifted and allowed us to unleash our potential."

"Once we had proven that curses can be the robot! You still have matches to play and broken we had nothing to fear."

Of all the intro videos in the pre-league season, ZWEI remained our personal favourite, but since that video the team has been awfully quiet on the OC front, we asked if we could expect more to follow:

"The week of coming up with our intro was hellish. Our team rallied immensely to come up with an intro by having most members on board collaborating to create something great. After producing that, it felt like our [engine] sort of turned off."

"When the curse lifted over our team it felt like the wrong time to get too ahead of ourselves. I think there was a point where we could have shifted our mentality back to producing more OC but with our team being very engaged with games, especially after seeing Rozen Maidens fall, reminded us of how perilous our position was. We're slowly turning the OC generating machine back on, and we have a lot of plans that we've been sitting on since the beginning."

"I feel a little guilty myself, because I pushed at the beginning of league to get us into gear, but then went on my own preoccupied misadventures" [Editor's note: see "Miko Uprising" Issue #5]

We asked if there was anything ZWEI's representative would like to add, and they had an appeal to the reading public:

"Shinjicat, if you are reading this: Stop running away, get back to HQ, and get in you need to stop grinching"

As our last question we of course asked for the gyaru's favourite Touhou:

"I think Seija is my favorite. I have others who I like a lot, but ultimately it's Seija."
